

SEEKING JUSTICE FOR THE VULNERABLE

"Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed. Take up the cause of the fatherless; plead the case of the widow." – Isaiah 1:17

Justice is a central theme in the Bible. This verse clearly describes one of God's priorities for how His people should live their lives. Pursuing justice involves placing God's value on all people everywhere, regardless of their race, religion, ethnicity, or social standing. It's about seeing others as God sees them – people created in His image. **Doing justice means restoring broken relationships and loving others well.** It requires us to do what is right, speak out against oppression, and stand up for society's most vulnerable.

HopeCo is an organization committed to pursuing justice. How do we do this?

We defend the oppressed, like 14-year-old Nancy, who was horribly and repeatedly abused by a man in her community. Our staff rescued Nancy from the abuse and the threat of child marriage, and she is now protected and safe. Nancy has returned to the classroom and is beginning to heal. And her abuser is now in prison, where he will never have the opportunity to hurt another precious girl.

We take up the cause of the fatherless, like sevenyear-old Samuel, who never knew his father and was neglected, hungry, and fearful when our staff first found him. Now, at City of Hope, he is healthy, a big fan of soccer and ugali (a traditional African dish), and an enthusiastic participant in church every Sunday morning! **We plead the case of the widow,** like Agatha, who was struggling to provide for her children alone. Agatha recently graduated from our women's empowerment program, where she has learned practical skills and received mentoring and care. She can now earn an income, feed her children, and send them to school. Agatha has new hope!

May we each allow God to stir our hearts for the poor. Let's be courageous and show the same compassion that Jesus had for the weak, the suffering, and the lost. And let's be encouraged that God equips us so that we can serve others and be generous. Together, we can make a difference in His world and for His glory!


Here's what three of these team members told us:
