




DREAMS COME TRUE FOR SELINA

no one was looking. She was known by all as a kind, sensitive young girl who looked after younger children needing help. Selina valued her education from a young age. If Selina couldn't be found on campus, all one needed to do was look in a classroom. When asked what she liked most about school, the list was long, "reading, math, geography, civics, and science." It's no wonder she was often at the top of her class!

This year, Selina's dream is coming true! She will graduate with a degree in Culinary Arts and Management. "I've always wanted to open my own restaurant, but I didn't have the skills or know-how to begin." Every year, more students like Salina will have the privilege to enroll in college or university to pursue their dreams for a hope-filled future!

We have 36 students enrolled in college with three graduating this year. They are pursuing majors in accounting, graphic design, computer science, nursing, culinary arts, management, and more.



New Location to Empower More Women



SEW (Sewing Empowers Women) of our Women's Empowerment Program has helped dozens of women in Kenya and Tanzania develop marketable skills to better provide for their young families. Often due to forced early marriages and child labor, many East African women are unable to finish their secondary or even primary education, limiting their opportunities to earn a living.

Josie* came to our program after escaping an abusive marriage. With no skills to adequately provide for her young children other than manual farm labor, she excitedly enrolled in the SEW program. During her two-year training, she learned sewing skills, bookkeeping, and how best to serve her customers. Josie graduated top of her class, and today she manages her own dressmaking business!

More women like Josie are waiting to be given this same opportunity. Our goal is to expand to a second Tanzanian location in Sirari, a hub for many surrounding villages. Unfortunately, prostitution is rampant in this border town. Giving more women marketable business skills will provide other income opportunities. We look forward to partnering with a local church to open this new

facility as soon as funding becomes available.

Helping More Children in Mitaboni, Kenya



Widespread poverty often leads to hopelessness, affecting everyone. Kids are hungry, malnourished, and sick so they drop out of school. Struggling parents sometimes abandon their children

Children left to fend for themselves suffer the risks of being abused and laboring long hours trying to fend off hunger. And, with no one to provide for or protect them, going to school is no longer an option – or a desire. Child-headed households, where children fill the absent-parent role of providing for and protecting their younger siblings, are all too common in Mitaboni, Kenya.

The good news is that HopeCo has partnered with a church in the US, and today 60+ children and families in the Mitaboni community have renewed hope. Working with a social worker and team, these kids are given nutritious meals, assistance with education, counseling, the love of Jesus – and knowing they are not forgotten. Older children are supported with their high school and college education, enabling them to break out of the poverty they have known. Parents are assisted, strengthened, and encouraged as they can provide for their own family's needs.

Growing our Care and Influence in 2024



House of Faraja is a refuge for the six girls currently living there. They receive traumainformed counseling and loving care, while continuing with their schooling. Stacy* (age nine), was rescued this past January and brought to our safe house. Her grandmother had sent her to a shop one evening and she was sexually assaulted by the

village elder who owned the shop. Enduring the stigma and shame, this young child was forced to remain in school, where the incident was the latest gossip. Stacy is happy to be at House of Faraja and is making new friends!



Destiny Primary and Dr. John Chacha Secondary Schools anchor our students with a professional, Christ-centered education, preparing them for college or vocational training and a hope-filled future.



Amani Medical Center's care and impact are spreading throughout the surrounding communities as more children and families come for treatment. Amani also offers health education classes (helping parents prevent illness), vaccinations, and child health programs. Once a year, Duke University School of Nursing sends a team of students to observe rural healthcare and interact with our students. Opportunities abound daily to pray and share the love of Jesus!

Sara* was brought to City of Hope last year, even though she had no sponsors. That's what HopeCo does. We bring orphans and children out of severe poverty and abusive situations because it's the right thing to do!

Child sponsorship is like inviting a child into your family – even though they live in another country. They get to know you,

and you get to know them. It takes time, but it's worth it. You contact your sponsored child as often as you like. Write letters, send pictures, hear what they have been learning the past year - and so much more. Sponsoring a child says to them, "You are precious to me"!
